If you can help on the day on a stall or to supervise the bouncy castle please contact Linda Baker or Revd Heather.

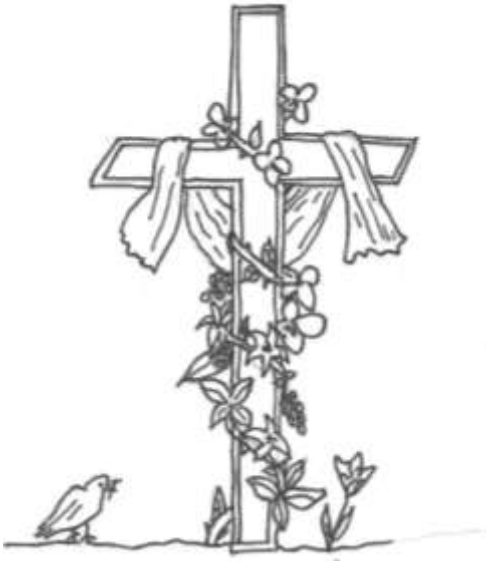
Volunteer Needed
