Christian Aid Collection for Kerala, India.

In what's said to be the worst rains in more than 100 years, over a million people have been affected by the unprecedented flooding in Kerala, southern India – with the loss of more than 400 lives during the monsoon season. Kerala's floods and landslides have left ruin so terrible that around 200,000 people will be unable to return home for at least six months, Christian Aid estimates. Even among houses that were not completely destroyed, many are now filled with mud, vegetation and rubbish, with collapsed roofs and walls. Many people have lost everything they had. Right now, Christian Aid and its local partners are on the ground responding to urgent needs of shelter, food and clean water for more than 12,000 people. Here, in Harnham we are collecting money for Christian Aid's Kerala Appeal on Sunday 16th September and Sunday 23rd Sept. Thank you.
