16<sup>th</sup> April - Wrotham to Merstham (26 miles)

17<sup>th</sup> April - Merstham to Guildford (23 miles)

Maundy Thursday - Guildford to Alton (22 miles)

Good Friday - Alton to Winchester on St. Swithun's Way (21 miles)

Holy Saturday – Winchester to Salisbury on the Clarendon Way (26 miles) arriving back in Salisbury between 1730 and 1800. On his arrival there will be a short service of thanksgiving in All Saints.
