When Christ freed us, he meant for us to remain free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery. Galatians 5: 1

- for those who are held down by past experiences, hurt or pain, that they may know the freedom that Christ can bring
- for the work of Amnesty international & Christians against torture.
- for those who are trapped in modern slavery.
- for the police force, judicial system, prison and probation workers

#### **SATURDAY** Faith

Only faith can guarantee the blessings that we hope for, or prove the existence of the realities that at present remain unseen. Hebrews 11: 1

- for those who want to grow in faith, that we may all be filled with the hope of what is to come.
- for those who are struggling with faith at this time.
- for our fellow brothers and sisters of the World Faiths.

**PENTECOST SUNDAY** They were all filled with the Holy Spirit. Acts 2: 4 Numbers 11 v 24-30; Acts 2 v 1-21; John 20 v 19-23

- for the whole Church to be filled with the Holy Spirit & faith renewed

- for our mission partners Jane and Derek Waller in Madagascar, for the Church Army, Church Urban Fund, The Bridge Schools Project.

## **SUNDAY** Intercession

- Pray for our School communities, colleges and university links and centres of learning in Salisbury e.g. the city library and U3A groups, Sarum College
- Pray that all wedding and baptism families, who in their celebrations of love and commitment, can experience God's love and actively seek it.

#### **WEDNESDAY** Seek

Search, and you will find. Matthew 7: 7b

- Pray for those who seek God, that their search may lead them to find their heart's desire.
- Pray for those who seek justice and mercy for anyone oppressed with injustice, or poverty.
- Pray for those seeking the key to a successful vaccination for Covid
  19 and those people who are part of the clinical trials.
