- Pray that as we see the brokenness of our world there would be healing among the nations; food where there is hunger; freedom where there is oppression; joy where there is pain; that love may bring peace to all God's children.
- Pray for those who have died and those who mourn.

In darkness and in light, in trouble and in joy, help us, heavenly Father, to trust your love, to serve your purpose, and to praise your name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
