Olivia Thomson sends the follow tips for Face Masks. "As it is now law to wear a mask to church services inside the buildings, a reminder that there are 3 local charity mask trees in Harnham if you still need one. They are in Hollows Close, Woodbury Gardens & Woodbury Lane or you can visit https://communitymasktrees.org/find-a-local-mask-tree/
Do you wear glasses & struggle with them steaming up when you've got a mask on? The easiest option I've found is to wash the lenses in soap. It can be washing up liquid, hand soap, shaving foam etc & rinse briefly in water & leave to air dry. You may have a few streaks on the lenses but try to avoid wiping them, as this is what helps prevent them steaming up."
