Please bring an umbrella to Outdoor worship to deal with the odd drop of rain. If wet on the morning there will be no service. Sorry for any inconvenience this may cause but none of our buildings can cope with large numbers at present – due to Covid restrictions.

Booking to attend the Sunday Church services is essential at present. Registering in advance makes the wardens job easier as all details are registered and GDPR permissions are sought in advance of the service to save time. (These are needed for "Track and Trace.") It also means you get a place. Seats for Sunday services are limited to keep you all safe, and it would be a shame if you made your way there on the off chance to find it fully booked – it has happened!
