**Harnham Recycling for Medic 2 Medic**


The Wooden Container outside the hall is to the right of the blue double doors in the car park and is available 24 hours a day! Please note from now you can now recycle the following:

- Please do not recycle the following: Plastic bags from supermarket Vegetables etc – these can be recycled at most Supermarkets. Blister Packs – recycle at Superdrug, Old George Mall or Avon Lodge Veterinary Group, 21, Stratford Rd.
