Tuesday 19 th	8.00pm	Stations of the Cross. A meditation on Jesus that links the stations of the cross and climate justice. (30 mins)
Sunday 24 th Palm Sunday	8.00am 9.45am 10.00am	BCP Holy Communion. All Saints. We gather by Old Mill Pub "pond" for the Palm procession to St George's. United Communion at St George's. We listen to the last days of Jesus life and share communion.
