This year the Electoral Roll starts from scratch.

Fill in the form online or in the churches. The deadline for applications this year is 1 May. To apply for the church electoral roll, you must:

- be 16 years old or over (although you can apply in the year you become 16 and you can be on the electoral roll once your birthday has passed)
- be baptised
- either live in the parish or have attended the church regularly for at least 6 months. We will keep your information secure in line with UK GDPR.
