Mosaic Middle East <u>https://mosaicmiddleeast.org</u> Supporting the Middle East, including St George's Church in Bagdad, and refugee centres in Jordan called the Olive Tree Centres which offer belonging, trauma therapy, and education programmes.

St George's Baghdad. Life and ministry at the Anglican church of St George, close to the River Tigris in Baghdad and near the heart of the huge city, is genuinely holistic. Worship on Sundays, usually led by Canon Faiz assisted by keen volunteers as acolytes and musicians. St George's is also the kindergarten, the school of the Redeemer, the medical clinic, the distribution of food relief to the very needy, the ecumenical resource centre, and more. Often St George's has been the venue for interfaith and intrafaith dialogue and reconciliation involving Shi'i and Sunni Muslims, Christians, Yezidis, and others, attended by politicians and key actors in civil society as well as religious leaders. St George's is a witness to persistence, faithfulness, and hope.
