Rev Canon Jonathan Herbert, Hammadi Charif, Miranda Pinch, Rev Hilary Bond, Dean of Salisbury Nicholas Papadopoulos. Do come to listen and learn from these reflections on the Nakba of 1948 and subsequent events in Israel Palestine. (Miranda's mother was a secular Jewish refugee from the Holocaust in 1938 who was always bitterly opposed to what was being done to the Palestinians in her name as a Jew.
