Do come to listen and learn from these reflections on the Nakba of 1948 and subsequent events in Israel Palestine. (Miranda's mother was a secular Jewish refugee from the Holocaust in 1938 who was always bitterly opposed to what was being done to the Palestinians in her name as a Jew. Miranda travelled in the occupied territories of Palestine at the end of last year and will tell us some of what she witnessed. Dean Nicholas will have just returned from Jerusalem.)
