October is Black History Month.

Brian Mackey was the first vicar of Jamaican and English descent in the Church of England. He was born in 1770 to William Mackey and an unnamed Jamaican lady (which probably means she was a slave). In 1780, by an act of the Jamaican

The Rev. Bryan Mackey, of Milton, Wilts, and late of Brasen Nose College, is presented by Wm. Tombs, Esq. to the valuable Rectory of Coates, Gloucestershire.

Assembly, Mackey was granted exemption from inheritance restrictions normally placed on those of African or part-African descent. He attended Brasenose College, Oxford, and was ordained Deacon. He became curate at Wootton Rivers, Wiltshire and then went on to become Rector of Coates and Sapperton, dying aged 77 in Southampton. Today 3.4 percent of all stipendiary clergy and 2.2% of senior staff, are from Black Ethnic Minority backgroundswhereas 4.7 percent of those who attend Church of England churches are from minority ethnic backgrounds.
