Nepal has been catapulted into our national news as a result of extensive political unrest in the country. Joanna will give a brief overview of the current political situation, but she will aim mainly to highlight what she has learned about Nepal itself, and also about both the benefits and dangers of international development assistance, and to share some of the significant positive shifts that have taken place there, small scale and local enough not to be mired in political corruption.
