## Advent Art and Meditation 12 noon to 1.15 in Field View next to Parish hall.



On Fridays 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Revd Becky will be leading a time of meditation in the style of Lectio Divina. Listening to God through the reading of a passage of scripture and responding to it by noticing what we are drawn to by God. We will explore the themes raised in the Tuesday evening talks with a personal response to the scriptures. The sessions will include a short piece of Taize music to help us settle into listening to God, followed by the scripture reading, followed by 10 minutes of silence, and 20 minutes of use of art materials to write, draw or paint a response. We end by taking it in turns, with anyone who wants to share, their thoughts of how God has spoken to them in the session.

All welcome- it is not about artistic ability but the desire to listen to God and respond.
