Remembering

In previous years we have been silent about women from Harnham who have died in the First World War. Many nurses who died as a result of their nursing are not officially remembered. And so this year, we will remember Nurse Dorothy Julia Rossiter, Dorrie, who died on 16th December 1914 aged just 22 years old. She died from cerebral meningitis, contracted whilst nursing Canadian soldiers in hospital. She is buried in All Saints' Churchyard, Harnham. (With thanks to Liddy T and Helen Roberts.)
