#### **We are looking for people!**

- A. Are you both good with people and organized and would like to verge for weddings, funerals or burials. This can involve: finding the grave spaces if necessary, set up the church ready, welcome those who attend, ensure the church is cleared afterwards. Time taken ranges from 1 hour to 3 hours. DBS and basic safeguarding training required. One off payment.
- B. Are you organized and concerned about the church buildings? Could you process the paperwork and invite the correct businesses to tender for the repair of St George's leaking roof. This will need leadwork across the join between the sanctuary roof and the chancel area. Volunteer.
- C. Do you like to be outside and enjoy history! Someone to keep an up-to-date record of our churchyards. Volunteer. Volunteers to tidy up St George's churchyard before the Patronal Festival.
- D. **People to read** in church. The readings are provided in advance. Volunteer.
- E. People who enjoy **governance**, with an overview of the mission of the parish. Six x 2 hour meetings of PCC per year with reading time of documentation before hand. Volunteer.
