**A thought from Revd Becky...**

The Ordinal of the Church of England is a liturgical book that contains the rites and prayers for the ordination of deacons, priests, and bishops, of the Church of England. Its roots lie in the English Reformation, particularly in the work of Archbishop Thomas Cranmer. It outlines the procedures for ordination. The 1662 version states 'Ye are called: that is to say, to be messengers, watchmen, and stewards of the Lord; to teach and to premonish, to feed and provide for the Lord's family; to seek for Christ's sheep that are dispersed abroad, and for his children who are in the midst of this naughty world, that they may be saved through Christ forever. Have always therefore printed in your remembrance, how great a treasure is committed to your charge. For they are the sheep of Christ, which he bought with his death, and for whom he shed his blood.'

What a lovely phrase – referring to a priest's responsibility towards people 'how great a treasure is committed to your charge.' Any calling is routed in God's love for us. We are all God's treasures and in response we are all called to love God and love our neighbours and to share the Good news of Christ to each new generation. I pray that as we support Revd Sophie in her calling as a priest, our own knowledge that we treasured by Christ will deepen, and our callings reaffirmed.
