A word from Revd Becky...

"And he showed me a little thing, the size of a hazelnut, on the palm of my hand, round like a ball. I looked at it thoughtfully and wondered, 'What is this?' And the answer came, 'It is all that is made.' I marvelled that it continued to exist and did not suddenly disintegrate; it was so small. And again, my mind supplied the answer, 'It exists, both now and for ever, because God loves it.' In short, everything owes its existence to the love of God. In this 'little thing' I saw three truths. The first is that God made it; the second is that God loves it; and the third is that God sustains it."

Julian of Norwich encompasses the essence of the Christian faith in beautiful imagery. God has created the world and sustains its being. God has also uniquely entrusted the care of creation to human beings. We must render an account of our stewardship not simply to God, but to the next generation of creatures that inhabit our shared earth. Beauty and challenge. The church has introduced a new feast day *Christ in Creation* to spur us on in active worship not just on a Sunday but in our everyday lifestyle choices. What will you change to meet this challenge? *Revd Becky*
